Unemployed people are being made to work for nothing – or have their benefits sanctioned for 13 weeks and be left destitute.

Going to work every day knowing you won't be paid is demeaning and soul destroying. It has also been shown to be useless in helping people find paid work.

In fact IT DESTROYS PAID JOBS.

Why would employers pay even the minimum wage if they can get people to work for nothing? And this affects workers in other places too. If they pay decent wages then how can they compete against a company that gets labour for nothing?

We are in danger of finding ourselves in a society where it is the norm to expect people to have to work without pay to earn the right to earn a living.

We can stop this exploitation by naming, shaming and boycotting the unscrupulous companies and organisations that make use of this government-sponsored slavery. These include big businesses like POUNDSTRETCHER and THE RANGE, and also charities and community organisations - thus undermining the whole concept of volunteering. Many unemployed people genuinely and willingly give a lot of time to their local communities, but charities should not rely on slavery! National charities who exploit workfare include DEBRA, the SALVATION ARMY and CATS PROTECTION. Local community organisations include MID-LIN DAY CARE and the DEAF HUB

WHAT YOU CAN DO TO END WORKFARE SLAVERY

Let people know what is happening

Boycott exploiting businesses and organisations until they withdraw from the scheme
